Training on domestic violence is essential as the response women receive to disclosures of abuse can have a major impact on their safety, and on their physical and emotional well-being. Whatever your role, this training will equip you with the skills and knowledge to provide an appropriate response to women experiencing domestic violence.

Day One on November 18th will focus on dealing with domestic violence situations and disclosures and developing good practice guidelines. Day Two on December 9th will look at myths and perceptions about perpetrators of domestic violence and will further enhance skills on dealing with domestic violence victims that approach services for help.
