

Review and Evaluation of Migrant Women Organisation's Work over a 10-Year

Akina Dada wa Africa (AkiDwA) is an NGO began by African women which seeks to promote equality and justice for migrant women living in Ireland. AkiDwA seeks to conduct an evaluation and strategic review that will help the organisation create AkiDwA's 2012-2015 strategic plan.

The evaluation and strategic review will assess the activities undertaken by AkiDwA during the lifespan of the organisation. The evaluation will involve consultation with AkiDwA's staff, members, board, advisory committee, and partner organisations. Key evaluations will include: AkiDwA's programme outcomes and the reason for their success or lack of success; cost-effectiveness and efficiency of the organisation; strength of internal and external communications; organisational capacity; and the success of outcomes for stakeholders.

The evaluation will commence by 11 July 2011 and end on 21 October 2011. The strategic review will commence by 11 July 2011 and end on 30 November 2011.
